


Our objectives at Woodford



We set out our objectives at Woodford CE Primary School:

- Develop playleaders in Year 5 through training sessions during lunchtimes on activities, then led to young pupils across the week.
- To improve engagement and motivation of 3 targeted pupils in an afternoon group mentoring session each week. (Can focus on teamwork, resilience and emotions).
- To increase & inspire physical activity participation for Girls in Year 4.




The delivery of quality PE lessons not just in football has given the pupils a high level of enthusiasm for physical activity across the school


which is something that is at the heart of our opportunities for pupils.
